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#### Fabric Requirements:

 Fabric A: 1/4 yd 6020 Amber

 Fabric B: 1/4 yd 5850 White

 Fabric C: 1/4 yd 5849 Slate

 Fabric D: 1/4 yd 6021 Multi

 Fabric E: 1/4 yd 5851 Amber

 Fabric F: 1/4 yd 6019 Slate

 Fabric G: 1/2 yd 5852 Green

 Fabric H: 1/3 yd 6022 Amber

 Fabric I: 1/3 yd 4389 Melon

 Fabric J: 1/2 yd 4391 Tutti Fruiti

 Fabric K: 1-3/4 yd Plain Black

 Fabric L: 2 yds 5848 Multi

 Fabric M: 3/8 yd 5853 Safari

 Backing: 3-1/2 yds 5853 Safari

#### **Cutting Instructions:**

Fabric A: Cut two 5-1/2" squares Cut two 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips


- Fabric B: Cut two 5-1/2" squares Cut two 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips
- Fabric C: Cut two 5-1/2" squares Cut two 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips
- Fabric D: Cut two 5-1/2" squares Cut two 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips
- Fabric E: Cut two 5-1/2" squares Cut two 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips
- **Fabric F:** Cut two 5-1/2" squares Cut two 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips
- Fabric G: Cut twelve 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips Cut twelve 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips
- Fabric H: Cut twelve 4-1/2" squares
- **Fabric I:** Cut twelve 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" strips Cut twelve 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips
- **Fabric J:** Cut twelve 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips Cut twelve 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips
- Fabric K: Cut twenty-four 1" x 4-1/2" strips Cut twenty-four 1" x 5-1/2" strips Cut forty-eight 1" x 6-1/2" strips Cut six 2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Piece the strips together to make two 2" x 50" strips & two 2" x 43-1/2" strips. Cut six 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding
- **Fabric L:** Cut three 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together to make two 4-1/2" x 51-1/2" Cut two 4-1/2" x 53" strips from the length of fabric.

Fabric M: Cut twelve 3" x 10-1/2" strips

**Backing:** Cut two 59" x WOF strips. Piece them together for the 59" x 69" backing.

### Assembly Instructions:

- Sew one 1" x 5-1/2" Fabric K strip to each side of one 5-1/2" Fabric A square. Sew one 1" x 6-1/2" Fabric K strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A square. Repeat with the second 5-1/2" Fabric A square to make two 6-1/2" Giraffe Blocks.
- 2. Repeat Step One with the two 5-1/2" squares from Fabric B, C, D, E and F, twenty 1" x 5-1/2" Fabric K strips and twenty 1" x 6-1/2" Fabric K strips to make two 6-1/2" blocks of each; zebra, hippo, gorilla, elephant and lion prints.
- 3. Sew one 1" x 4-1/2" Fabric K strip to each side of one 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" Fabric A strip. Sew one 1" x 6-1/2" Fabric K strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A strip. Repeat with the second 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" Fabric A strip to make two 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" Giraffe Blocks.
- **4.** Repeat Step One with the two 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" squares from Fabric B, C, D, E and F, twenty 1" x 4-1/2" Fabric K strips and twenty 1" x 6-1/2" Fabric K strips to make two 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" blocks of each; zebra, hippo, gorilla, elephant and lion prints.
- 5. Refer to the block layout and quilt photo to assemble twelve 10-1/2" x 14-1/2" blocks.
- 6. Refer to the quilt photo and starting with the 10-1/2" x 14-1/2" block, sew together three blocks and three 3" x 10-1/2" Fabric M strips, alternating them, to make the first vertical row. Repeat to make the third vertical row.
- 7. Refer to the quilt photo and starting with the 3-1/2" x 14-1/2" Fabric M strip, sew together three blocks and three 3" x 10-1/2" Fabric M strips, alternating them, to make the second vertical row. Repeat to make the forth vertical row.
- 8. Sew the vertical rows together to make the quilt top.
- **9.** Sew one 2" x 50" Fabric K strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2" x 43-1/2" Fabric K strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 10. Sew one 4-1/2" x 53" Fabric L strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 4-1/2" x 51-1/2" Fabric L strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 11. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
