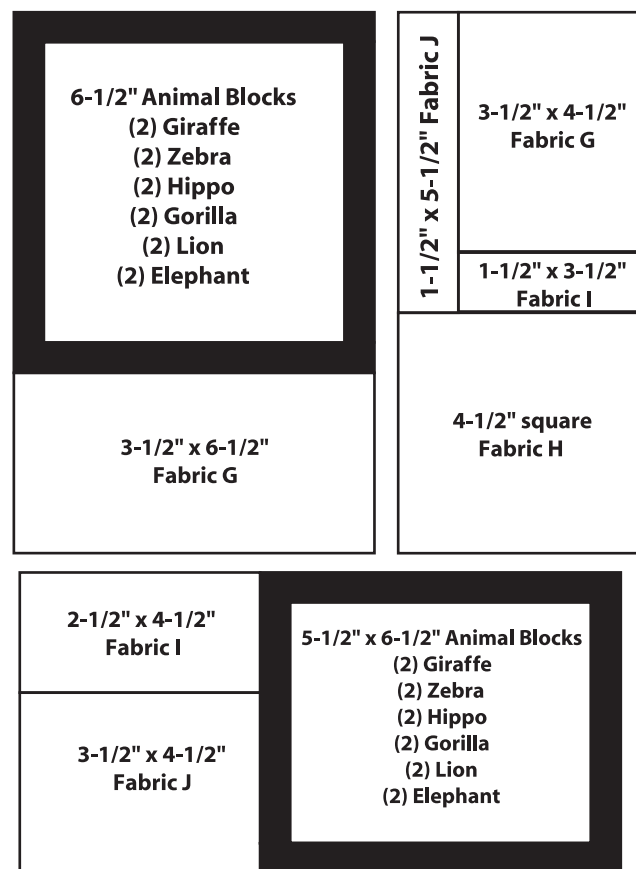
- Fabric A:** 1/4 yd 6020 Amber
- Fabric B:** 1/4 yd 5850 White
- Fabric C:** 1/4 yd 5849 Slate
- Fabric D:** 1/4 yd 6021 Multi
- Fabric E:** 1/4 yd 5851 Amber
- Fabric F:** 1/4 yd 6019 Slate
- Fabric G:** 1/2 yd 5852 Green
- Fabric H:** 1/3 yd 6022 Amber
- Fabric I:** 1/3 yd 4389 Melon
- Fabric J:** 1/2 yd 4391 Tutti Frutti
- Fabric K:** 1-3/4 yd Plain Black
- Fabric L:** 2 yds 5848 Multi
- Fabric M:** 3/8 yd 5853 Safari
- Backing:** 3-1/2 yds 5853 Safari

Cutting Instructions:

- Fabric A:** Cut two 5-1/2" squares
Cut two 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips
- Fabric B:** Cut two 5-1/2" squares
Cut two 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips
- Fabric C:** Cut two 5-1/2" squares
Cut two 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips
- Fabric D:** Cut two 5-1/2" squares
Cut two 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips
- Fabric E:** Cut two 5-1/2" squares
Cut two 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips
- Fabric F:** Cut two 5-1/2" squares
Cut two 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips
- Fabric G:** Cut twelve 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips
Cut twelve 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips
- Fabric H:** Cut twelve 4-1/2" squares
- Fabric I:** Cut twelve 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" strips
Cut twelve 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips
- Fabric J:** Cut twelve 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips
Cut twelve 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips
- Fabric K:** Cut twenty-four 1" x 4-1/2" strips
Cut twenty-four 1" x 5-1/2" strips
Cut forty-eight 1" x 6-1/2" strips
Cut six 2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips.
Piece the strips together to make two
2" x 50" strips & two 2" x 43-1/2" strips.
Cut six 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding
- Fabric L:** Cut three 4-1/2" x WOF strips.
Piece the strips together to make two 4-1/2" x 51-1/2"
Cut two 4-1/2" x 53" strips from the length of fabric.
- Fabric M:** Cut twelve 3" x 10-1/2" strips
- Backing:** Cut two 59" x WOF strips.
Piece them together for the 59" x 69" backing.

Assembly Instructions:

1. Sew one 1" x 5-1/2" Fabric K strip to each side of one 5-1/2" Fabric A square. Sew one 1" x 6-1/2" Fabric K strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A square. Repeat with the second 5-1/2" Fabric A square to make two 6-1/2" Giraffe Blocks.
2. Repeat Step One with the two 5-1/2" squares from Fabric B, C, D, E and F, twenty 1" x 5-1/2" Fabric K strips and twenty 1" x 6-1/2" Fabric K strips to make two 6-1/2" blocks of each; zebra, hippo, gorilla, elephant and lion prints.
3. Sew one 1" x 4-1/2" Fabric K strip to each side of one 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" Fabric A strip. Sew one 1" x 6-1/2" Fabric K strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A strip. Repeat with the second 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" Fabric A strip to make two 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" Giraffe Blocks.
4. Repeat Step One with the two 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" squares from Fabric B, C, D, E and F, twenty 1" x 4-1/2" Fabric K strips and twenty 1" x 6-1/2" Fabric K strips to make two 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" blocks of each; zebra, hippo, gorilla, elephant and lion prints.
5. Refer to the block layout and quilt photo to assemble twelve 10-1/2" x 14-1/2" blocks.
6. Refer to the quilt photo and starting with the 10-1/2" x 14-1/2" block, sew together three blocks and three 3" x 10-1/2" Fabric M strips, alternating them, to make the first vertical row. Repeat to make the third vertical row.
7. Refer to the quilt photo and starting with the 3-1/2" x 14-1/2" Fabric M strip, sew together three blocks and three 3" x 10-1/2" Fabric M strips, alternating them, to make the second vertical row. Repeat to make the fourth vertical row.
8. Sew the vertical rows together to make the quilt top.
9. Sew one 2" x 50" Fabric K strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2" x 43-1/2" Fabric K strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
10. Sew one 4-1/2" x 53" Fabric L strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 4-1/2" x 51-1/2" Fabric L strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
11. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
