



Panel Quilt Cutting Requirements Seams are ¼", wof=width of fabric

Quilt measures 72" x 90"

Panel 7485/33 cut to 22 1/2" x 40 1/2"

Pale Cream Dot 7490/44 (Border one & three)

- (4) 3" x wof stripes. Piece together end to end and cut:
 - (2) 3" x 53 ½" (border three)
 - (2) 3" x 27 ½" (border one)
- (4) 3" x 40 ½" (border one & three)

Cream Flowers 7487/44 (Border two)

- (4) 4 1/2" x wof strips. Piece together end to end and cut:
 - (2) 4 ½" x 45 ½"
 - (2) 4 ½ " x 35 ½"

Agua Stars 7489/11 (Border four & six)

- (10) 1 ½" x wof strips, pieced together end to end and cut:
 - (2) 1 ½" x 58 ½" (border four)
 - (2) 1 ½" x 42 ½" (border four)
 - (2)1 ½" x 72 ½" (border six)
 - (2) 1 ½" x 56 ½"(border six)

Pink Flowers 7487/22 (Half-square triangles)

(4) 6 %" strips, sub cut into (19) 6 %" squares

Cream Stripe 7491/44

(4) 6 %" strips, sub cut into (19) 6 %" squares

Cream Fairies 7488/44 (Border seven)

- (7) 3 ½" x wof strips, pieced together end to end and cut:
 - (2) 3 ½" x 74 ½"
 - (2) 3 ½" x 62 ½"

Blue Flowers 7487/11 (Border eight, outer border)

- (8) 5 ½" x wof strips, pieced together end to end and cut:
 - (2) 5 ½" x 80 ½" strips
 - (2) 5 ½" x 72 ½" strips

Green Dot 7490/66

(9) 2 1/2" x wof strips pieced together end to end for binding.

The panel is framed with eight borders. When adding the borders to the panel, sew the sides on first and then the top and bottom. Press away from the panel when adding the borders.


Sew on borders one through four. At this point, your quilt should measure 42 ½" x 60 ½".

Half Square Triangle Blocks (6 1/2" unfinished) Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a 6 %" pink flower square. With right sides together, pair with a 6 1/8" cream stripe square. Please note the vertical direction of the stripes when piecing the blocks. Sew ¼" from each side of the drawn line.



Cut apart on the line. Press seam to one side. Make (38).





Make 38

Sew (10) half square triangles blocks together for each side border. Please note orientation of the blocks.

Sew (9) blocks together for the top and bottom border. Please note orientation of the corner blocks in the top and bottom border strips.

Now, add borders six through eight.

That's it! You are finished!

Border One

Quilt and bind with green dot.

Pale Cream Dot

(2) 3" x 40 1/2" sides

(2) 3" x 27 1/2" top & bottom

Border Two Cream Flowers

(2) 4 1/2" x 45 1/2" sides

(2) 4 ½" x 35 ½" top & bottom

Border Three Pale Cream Dot

(2) 3" x 53 ½" sides

(2) 3" x 40 1/2" top and bottom

Border Four Aqua Stars

(2) 1 ½" x 58 ½" sides

(2) 1 ½" x 42 ½" top and bottom

Border Five Half Square Triangle Blocks

(2) 6 1/2" x 60 1/2" sides

(2) 6 1/2" x 54 1/2" top and bottom

Border Six **Aqua Stars**

(2) 1 ½" x 72 ½" sides

(2) 1 ½" x 56 ½" top and bottom

Border Seven Cream Fairies


(2) 3 ½" x 74 ½" sides

(2) 3 1/2" x 62 1/2" top and bottom

Border Eight Blue Flowers

(2) 5 ½" x 80 ½" sides

(2) 5 ½" x 72 ½" top and bottom



Pieced Block Quilt Cutting Requirements

Quilt measures 72" x 90"

Seams are ¼", wof=width of fabric

Blue Flowers 7487/11

- (2) 9 1/2" x wof strips, sub cut into:
 - (6) 9 1/2" squares
- (8) 5 ½" x wof strips, pieced together end to end and cut:
 - (2) 5 ½" x 80 ½" strips (outer border)
 - (2) 5 1/2" x 72 1/2" strips (outer border)

Pink Flowers 7487/22

- (2) 9 ½" x wof stripe, sub cut into:
 - (6) 9 1/2" squares

Cream Fairies 7488/44

(6) 18 1/2" squares

Pale Cream Dots 7490/44

(2) 9 ½" x wof stripe, sub cut into:

(6) 9 ½" squares

Cream Stripe 7491/44

(2) 9 ½" x wof stripe, sub cut into:

(6) 9 1/2" squares

Aqua Stars 7489/11 (inner border)

(7) 1 ½" x wof strips, pieced together end to end and cut:

(2)1 ½" x 72 ½"

(2)1 ½" x 56 ½"

Cream Flowers 7487/44 (middle border)

(7) 3 ½" x wof strips, pieced together end to end and cut:

(2) 3 ½" x 74 ½"

(2) 3 ½" x 62 ½"


Green Dot 7490/66

(9) 2 ½" x wof strips pieced together end to end for binding.

Piecing

Four Patch blocks (18 ½" unfinished)

Sew 9 ½" squares of pink flowers and pale cream dot together. Sew 9 ½" squares of cream stripe and blue flowers together. Sew these units into a four patch block. Make 6 blocks.



Make (6) 18 1/2" blocks

Alternate the four-patch blocks and $18 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares cream fairies and sew into four rows of three blocks. Press rows in opposite directions.

Add Borders, side borders first and then the top and bottom borders. Press toward the borders.

Inner Border: 1 ½" Teal stars Middle Border: 3 ½" Cream Flowers Outer Border: 5 ½" Blue Flowers.

Quilt and bind with green dot.

<u>Basic Bed Skirt</u>

Seams are ½"

Take your mattress off the bed. Measure the length and width of your box springs. Add 1 ½" to each to allow for the seams. Measure the "drop" of the bed so that you can determine how wide your fabric that drops from the box spring to the floor should be. Add two inches for the seam and hem allowance.

Your base will be the width and length of your box springs plus 1 ½". A gathered skirt will need twice the amount of fabric as you measured for the length and width to accommodate for the fullness of the skirt. To make the fabric easier to handle, do not join the panels together until you have finished the gathers. When the gathers are done, you will join the panels at the seams.

Turn under ½" twice for the hem on the bottom of each "drop piece" before you do the gathers. Press the hems and machine stitch. To make gathers, work two rows of gathering (long) stitches at the top edge of each panel approximately ½" from the top. Pull the gathering threads to form the gathers and secure threads to avoid unravelling.

After you have formed all your gathers, join the panels together at the edges with a ½" seam allowance. The panels can now be joined to the base. Double stitch seam for added strength. Your bed skirt is now complete. Lay the skirt over the box springs and replace the mattress.

Pillow Case

For one pillow case cut: 1 panel 27" x 42" Main Body 1 panel 11" x 42" Contrasting Band 1 strip 3 ½" x 42" Trim Accent



With wrong sides together, fold the contrasting band in half lengthwise and press. Repeat with the trim.

Baste the folded trim strip to the band 1/8
