Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of the fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge.

From the book panel, cut:

(12) 5 3/4" x 5 3/4" squares with a printed book "page" centered in each square.

From the green stripe, cut:

2 ¼" *bias* strips to make 195" of bias binding.

From the red stripe, cut:

- (2) $2 \frac{3}{8}$ " strips. Trim each strip to $37 \frac{1}{2}$ ".
- (2) 2 ¼" strips. Trim each strip to 32 ½".

From the white stockings, cut:

Note: Pieces for this fabric must be cut in the order given.

- (2) 1 ½" strips. Trim each strip to 35 ½".
- Trim a piece 11 ½" wide from the remaining fabric. Recut this piece into (2) 4 ½" high x 5 ½" wide pieces.
- (2) 1 ½" strips. Trim each strip to 28 ¾".

From EACH of the green dot, red dot, blue candy canes, green candy canes, red candy canes, blue snowflake, green snowflake and red snowflake fabrics cut:

(2) 2 ¼" strips. Recut into (4) 2 ¼" x 9 ¼" and (4) 2 ¼" x 5 ¾" pieces.

From the blue trees, cut:

- (1) 2 ¼" strip. Recut into (2) 2 ¼" x 9 ¼" and (2) 2 ¼" x 5 ¾" pieces.
- (1) 4 ½" strip. Recut into (2) 4 ½" x 5 ½" pieces.

From EACH of the remaining (7) fabrics, cut:

- (1) 5 ½" strip. Cut these (7) strips into a total of: (4) 5 ½" x 5 ½" squares,
 - (18) 5" x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces, and
 - (12) 4 ½" x 5 ½" pieces.

Sewing Instructions

All seams are sewn using 1/4" seam allowance with pieces held right sides together and raw edges even.

1. Using the quilt pictured on the cover, layout the printed squares from the book panel as shown in the diagram below.

2. Stitch 2 ¼" x 5 ¾" red snowflake print strips to the right and left sides of the title page of the book which should be in the position of square 1. Press the seams toward the red strips. Sew 2 ¼" x 9 ¼" red snowflake print strips to the top and bottom of the printed square to complete one block. Press these seams toward the red strips. Repeat this procedure for each of the book pages placed in squares 3, 5, 7, 9 and 11 referring to the quilt pictured on the cover for correct fabric placement.



3. Stitch 2 ¼" x 5 ¾" blue candy cane strips to the top and bottom of the book page in the position of square 2. Press the seams toward the blue strips. Sew 2 ¼" x 9 ¼" blue candy cane strips to the right and left sides of the printed square to complete one block. Press these seams toward the blue strips. Repeat this procedure for each of the book pages in squares 4, 6, 8, 10, and 12 referring to the quilt pictured on the cover for correct fabric placement.




Quilt Assembly

- 1. Referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram on the next page and the quilt pictured on the cover, arrange the blocks into (4) rows with (3) blocks in each row. Stitch the blocks into rows making sure all of the printed squares are oriented correctly. Sew the rows together to complete the quilt center.
- 2. Stitch a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $35\frac{1}{2}$ white stocking print piece to the right and left sides of the quilt top. Sew $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $28\frac{3}{4}$ " white stocking print pieces to the top and bottom.
- 3.Stitch 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ " red stripe strips to the right and left sides of the quilt top. Stitch 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ " red stripe strips to the top and bottom.
- 4. Again referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram and the quilt pictured on the cover, stitch together (9) 5" x 5 ½" pieces to make a 5 ½" x 41" pieced strip. Repeat to make a second unit. Sew these pieced borders to the right and left sides of the quilt top.

Quilt Assembly (cont.)

- 5. Sew (8) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces together to make a $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $32\frac{1}{2}$ " pieced strip. Repeat to make a second unit. Stitch a $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square to each end of each pieced strip. Sew these pieced borders to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.
- 6. Layer the completed quilt top with batting and backing and quilt as desired.
- 7. Trim the batting and backing even with the quilt top and bind using the 2 ¼" green stripe bias strips.
