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Fabric Requirements:

- Fabric A:** 1/3 yd of M5993 Black
Fabric B: 1/3 yd of M5991 Black
Fabric C: 5/8 yd of M5994 Black
Fabric D: 5/8 yd of M5992 Black
Fabric E: 1-3/4 yds of M5995 Black
Fabric F: 1 yd of 4368 Lime
Fabric G: 1-1/2 yds of 4368 Violet
Fabric H: 1/3 yd of 4368 Butter
Fabric I: 1/2 yd of 4368 Rose
Fabric J: 1-1/4 yds of M5990 Black
Backing: 4 yds of M5995 Black

Cutting Instructions:

- Fabric A:** Cut two 4-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Cut the strips into ten 4-1/2" squares.
- Fabric B:** Cut two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Cut the strips into ten 4-1/2" squares.
- Fabric C:** Cut two 8-1/2" x WOF strips. Cut the strips into six 8-1/2" squares.
- Fabric D:** Cut two 8-1/2" x WOF strips. Cut the strips into six 8-1/2" squares.
- Fabric E:** Cut eighteen 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Cut the strips into (288) 2-1/2" squares.
Cut one 8-1/2" x WOF strip. Cut the strips into fourteen 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips.
- Fabric F:** Cut three 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Cut the strips into twenty-four 4-1/2" squares.
Cut three 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Cut the strips into forty 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips.
- Fabric G:** Cut three 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Cut the strips into twenty-four 4-1/2" squares.
Cut two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Cut the strips into thirty-one 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips.
Cut six 2" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together to make two 2" x 56-1/2" strips
and two 2" x 47-1/2" strips.
Cut seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.
- Fabric H:** Cut two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Cut the strips into thirty-one 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips.
- Fabric I:** Cut three 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Cut the strips into forty 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips.
- Fabric J:** Cut six 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together to make four 6-1/2" x 59-1/2" strips.
- Backing:** Cut two 67" x WOF strips. Piece them together to make the 67" x 79" backing.

Square-in-a-Square Block Instructions:

1. To make one square-in-a-square block, place one 4-1/2" Fabric G square to the top left corner of one 8-1/2" Fabric C square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric 1/4" from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.
2. Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a 4-1/2" Fabric G square to each of the remaining corners of the 8-1/2" Fabric C square to make one square-in-a-square block.
3. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make six 8-1/2" Fabric C square-in-a-square blocks.
4. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 with six 8-1/2" Fabric D squares and twenty-four 4-1/2" Fabric F squares to make six 8-1/2" Fabric D square-in-a-square blocks.

Flying Geese Instructions:

5. Place one 2-1/2" Fabric E square on the left side of one 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 5). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.
6. Place another 2-1/2" Fabric E square on the right side of the 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 7). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.
7. Repeat Steps 5 and 6 to make forty Fabric F/E flying geese, thirty-one Fabric G/E flying geese, thirty-one Fabric H/E flying geese and forty Fabric I/E flying geese units.
8. Following Figure 8, sew together one of each color flying goose units to make one sashing strip. Repeat to make thirty-one 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" sashing strip. You will have nine Pink and nine Green flying geese left over.

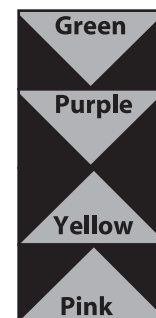

Quilt Top Instructions:

9. Refer to the quilt photo to sew together two 2-1/2" Fabric E squares, two Fabric F/E flying geese, two Fabric I/E flying geese units and three 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric E strips to make the Row One. Repeat to make Row Eleven.
10. Refer to the quilt photo to sew together one Fabric F/E flying goose unit, one Fabric I/E flying goose unit, two 4-1/2" Fabric A squares, two 4-1/2" Fabric B squares and three sashing strips to make Row Two. Repeat to make Rows Six and Ten.
11. Refer to the quilt photo to sew together two 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric E strips, four sashing strips, two Fabric C square-in-a-square blocks and one Fabric D square-in-a-square block to make Row Three. Repeat to make Row Seven.
12. Refer to the quilt photo to sew together one Fabric I/E flying goose unit, one Fabric F/E flying goose unit, two 4-1/2" Fabric A squares, two 4-1/2" Fabric B squares and three sashing strips to make Row Four. Repeat to make Row Eight.
13. Refer to the quilt photo to sew together two 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric E strips, four sashing strips, two Fabric D square-in-a-square blocks and one Fabric C square-in-a-square block to make Row Five. Repeat to make Row Nine.
14. Refer to the quilt photo to sew the eleven rows together in numerical order to make the quilt top.
15. Sew one 2" x 56-1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2" x 47-1/2" Fabric G strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
16. Sew one 6-1/2" x 59-1/2" Fabric J strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 6-1/2" x 59-1/2" Fabric J strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
17. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
