## ~Cutting Instructions: ~

From the CREAM DOT fabric, cut:
$3-31 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 44^{\prime \prime}$ strips and cut into $36-31 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares
From the BLACK DOT fabric, cut:
3-3 $1 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 44^{\prime \prime}$ strips and cut into $36-31 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares
$5-23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 44^{\prime \prime}$ strips and cut into $72-23 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

12 FAT QUARTERS Or 24 FAT EIGHTHS in assorted colors for the blocks
1 GREEN fat quarter for the appliquéd trees $1 / 3$ yard of CREAM DOT for the pinwheel blocks
3/4 yard of BLACK DOT for chain and pinwheel block
$11 / 4$ yards of BLACK STRIPE for first border and binding
$5 / 8$ yard of RED for middle border
$11 / 3$ yards of BLUE FLORAL for outer border
5 yards of BACKING fabric
$70^{\prime \prime} \times 92^{\prime \prime}$ piece of BATTING

From each of the FAT QUARTERS, cut: (if using fat eighths, cut into 3 strips and cut only 2 of each size) $6-23 / 4 " \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Cut the strips into 4 of each of the following sizes:

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23 / 4 \text { " } \times 9 \text { 1/2/2", } 23 / 4 \text { " } \times 7 \text { ¹/4", } 23 / 4 \text { " x } 5 \text { " and } 23 / 4 \text { " squares }
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From the BLACK STRIPE fabric, cut:
$5-23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 44^{\prime \prime}$ strips and cut into $10-23 / /^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
From the RED fabric, cut:
6-2 3/4" $\times 44^{\prime \prime}$ strips

From the BLUE FLORAL fabric, cut:
7-6 ${ }^{1 / 4^{\prime \prime}} \times 44^{\prime \prime}$ strips
From the BINDING (BLACK STRIPE) fabric cut: 7-3 ${ }^{1 / 4^{\prime \prime}} \times 44^{\prime \prime}$ strips

## Assem6ly Instructions

1. Lay two cream and black dot $31 / s^{\prime \prime}$ squares right sides together and draw a diagonal line across the back side of the block. Sew $1 / 4$ " away from either side of the line and cut apart on the drawn line. Press the seams toward the black dot and proof the blocks to $23 / 4$ ".

2. Sew the half-square triangle blocks together with the black dot $23 / 4$ " squares and the colored $23 / 4$ " strips as shown. Press the seams toward the black dot. Sew the rows together as shown and press. The block should measure $113 / 4$ "


Make 24 blocks
3. Sew the blocks together into rows, pressing the seams in alternating directions. Sew the rows together and press these seams open. The quilt should now measure $451 / 2 " \times 68$ ". Sew the remaining half-square triangle blocks together with the black stripe rectangles as shown in the color picture. Sew the side strips to the quilt first, then the top and bottom. The quilt should now measure 50 " x $721 / 2$ ".
4. If desired, add the appliqué now, using your favorite method.
5. Adding the Borders: Sew all of the red strips together end to end. Cut off two lengths at $721 / 2$ " and sew to the sides of the quilt. Cut off two lengths at $541 / 2$ " and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew all of the blue floral strips together end to end. Cut off 2 lengths at $761 / 2$ " and sew to the sides of the quilt. Cut off two lengths at 66 " and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Quilt and bind using the black stripe strips.
